When she does this, she is looking for issues that need to be fixed and she takes action on those issues. A few of the things that Sue has done behind the scenes include:

- Researching who is on the Board of our parent company, The Lake at Cherry Lane, and working with them to clean up the trees on Teter Blvd. These trees were losing limbs that were falling onto homes in The Fairways and causing damage. There was confusion regarding which association was responsible for the maintenance and cost of this area and Sue worked to resolve the issue, which saved The Fairways a lot of money.
- Obtaining bids for each homeowner for work that needed to be completed prior to the homes being painted in September, with the assistance of Debbie Downey. This took a lot of her time and her efforts are appreciated. It also identified that several of the homes had black mold under the siding which would have destroyed the structure of the dwelling and caused health issues.
- Obtaining bids for landscaping, tree and shrub removal, tree maintenance, and many other services.
- Working with the City of Meridian and The Lake at Cherry Lane to clean up the access road at the north end of The Fairways.
- Working with the landscaping companies to resolve homeowner issues.
