BY-LAWS

of Parkwood Meadows Homeowners Association, Inc.

Article I Name and Location

The name of the Association is Parkwood Meadows Homeowners Association, Inc. Meetings of members and directors may be held at such locations as the Board of Directors shall designate.

Article II Purpose

The purpose of the Association shall be to provide for maintenance, preservation and architectural control of the residence Lots and the Common Area within the Property.

Article III Definitions

- 3.1 Association: Association shall mean Parkwood Meadows Homeowners Association, Inc., an Idaho non-profit corporation, its successors and assigns, and the "Association" authorized by Article I, Section 1.3 of the Declaration.
- 3.2 Assessments: Assessments shall mean those payments required of Members by virtue of Article IV of the Declaration, or by law or equity, including Regular, Special and Limited Assessments.
- 3.3 Association Rules: Association Rules shall mean those rules and regulations promulgated by the Association governing conduct upon the use of the Property under the jurisdiction or control of the association, the imposition of fees and penalties for violation of Association Rules and Regulations as printed in the current Owner's Handbook, and procedural matters for use in the conduct of business of the Association.

- 3.4 Board: Board shall mean the Board of Directors of the Association.
- 3.5 Building Lot: Building Lot shall mean and refer to any plot of land showing upon any recorded plat of the Property with the exception of Common Area.
- 3.6 *Common Area*: Common Area shall mean all real property owned by the Association.
- 3.7 Declaration and Supplemental Declaration: Declaration and Supplemental Declaration shall refer to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for Parkwood Meadows Subdivisions as amended, originally recorded as Instrument 9326241, as amended and supplemented from time to time.
- 3.8 *Improvement:* Improvement shall mean any structure, facility, or system or other improvement or object, whether permanent or temporary, which is erected, constructed or placed upon, under or in any portion of the Property, including but not limited to buildings, fences, streets, drives, driveways, sidewalks, curbs, landscaping, signs, lights, mailboxes, electrical lines, pipes, pumps, ditches, waterways, swimming pools, and other recreational facilities and fixtures of any kind whatsoever.
- 3.9 Lot: Lot shall mean a building lot in Parkwood Meadows Subdivisions.
- 3.10 *Member:* Member shall mean each person or entity holding a membership in the Association pursuant to Article III, Section 3.2 of the Declaration.
- 3.11 *Owner:* Owner shall mean the owner of a Lot as defined by Article I, Section 1.17 of the Declaration.
- 3.12 *Plat:* Plat shall mean the plat as defined by Article I, Section 1.18 of the Declaration, currently the Plat of Parkwood Meadows Subdivision No.1 and Parkwood Meadows Subdivision No.2.
- 3.13 *Property:* Property or properties shall mean all the land included in the Plat.

Article IV Meeting of Members

- 4.1 *Annual Meeting:* The annual meeting of the members shall be held at a date, time, and place to be determined by the Board.
- 4.2 Special Meeting: Special meetings of the members may be called at any time by the President or by the Board, or upon written request of the members who are entitled to vote one-fourth of all the votes.
- 4.3 Notice of Meeting: Written notice of each meeting of the members shall be given by mailing a copy of a notice at least 10 days, but not more than 30 days before the meeting to each member entitled to vote, addressed to the member's address last appearing on the books of the Association. The notice shall specify the place, date, time, and purpose of the meeting.
- 4.4 *Quorum*: The presence at any meeting of members entitled to cast, or of proxies entitled to cast, twenty percent (20%) of the votes of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum for any action.
- 4.5 *Proxies:* At all meetings of members, each member may vote in person or by proxy. All proxies shall be in writing and filed with the Secretary. Every proxy shall be revocable and shall automatically cease upon conveyance of ownership of property by an owner.

Article V Board of Directors

5.1 *Number:* The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of three individuals who must be members of the Association in good standing. Good standing means the members are current on Association dues and are not the subject of unresolved official violations as of the date of election.

- 5.2 *Term of Office:* Board members shall be elected for a term of three consecutive years. A board member may serve more than one term but not more than two consecutive terms. Terms will be staggered by electing one third of the directors each year.
- 5.3 *Vacancy:* In the event of death, resignation or removal, a successor may be appointed by the remaining members of the Board and shall serve the remainder of the term of the director who left.
- 5.4 Removal: A board member who misses three successive board meeting may be removed from office by the remaining board members. A board member may be removed for cause by majority vote of members at a special meeting called for this purpose.
- 5.5 Compensation: Directors shall receive no compensation of any kind for service rendered to the Association in their capacity as directors. A director may receive reimbursement for actual expenses incurred in the performance of duties as a director. Said expenses must be approved before the expenditure by the President or the Treasurer. Board members shall not be employees of or contractors to the Association.
- 5.6 Action Taken without a Meeting: The directors shall have the right to take any action in the absence of a meeting which they could take at a meeting by obtaining the written approval of a majority of the directors. Any action taken in this manner shall have the same effect as though taken at a meeting of the directors.

Article VI Nomination and Election of Directors

- 6.1 *Nomination*: Nominations may be made by a nominating committee appointed by the Board and the names of the nominees shall be part of the notice of the annual meeting given in accordance with Section 4.3. Nominations also may be made by any Member from the floor at the annual meeting.
- 6.2 *Election*: Election to the Board shall be by written ballot or by raise of hand at each annual meeting of the members. At each such election, the members and their proxies may cast, in respect to each vacancy, as many votes as they are entitled to exercise under the provisions of the

Declaration. The persons receiving the largest number of votes shall be elected. In the event only one person is nominated for a given position then the vote will be called to approve or oppose the candidate.

Article VII Powers an Duties of the Board of Directors

- 7.1 *Powers:* The Board shall have power to:
 - a. Elect a Chairman of the Board: The election of a Board Chairman may take place at the first meeting of the Board of Directors following each annual meeting of the members. The Chairman shall direct the affairs of the Board and preside at all meetings of the Board.
 - b. Adopt and publish rules and regulations governing the use of common area and facilities, and the conduct of the members and their guests, and to establish enforcement procedures for the rules and regulations it sets.
 - c. Suspend the voting rights of a member during any period in which a member shall be in default in the payment of any assessment levied by the Association. Such rights may also be suspended after notice and hearing, for a period not to exceed 30 days for infraction of published rules and regulations.
 - d. Exercise all powers, duties, and authority vested in or delegated to the Association and not reserved to the members by other provisions of the By-Laws, the Articles of Incorporation, the Declaration, or the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act.
 - e. Declare the office of a member of the Board to be vacant in the event such member is absent from three consecutive regular meetings of the Board of Directors.
 - f. Employ a manager, an independent contractor, or such other employees or contractors as necessary and to prescribe their duties.

- 7.2 Duties: Duties of the Board of Directors shall be to:
 - a. Keep a complete record of all its acts and corporate affairs.
 - b. Supervise officers, agents, employees and contractors of the Association.
 - c. Subject to the limitations of Article IV, Section 4.3.1, fix the amount of the annual assessment against each lot at least thirty days in advance of each annual assessment due date.
 - d. Send written notice of each assessment to every owner subject thereto at least thirty days in advance of each annual assessment due date.
 - e. Take such action as may be necessary to establish a lien against any property for nonpayment of assessments.
 - f. Within a reasonable time, record a claim of lien against any property for which assessments are not paid within thirty days after the due date, or bring an action at law against the owner obligated to pay the assessment, or both.
 - g. Procure and maintain adequate liability and hazard insurance on property owned by the Association.
 - h. Cause all officers, agents, employees, and contractors of the Association to be covered by bonds and liability and hazard insurance as it may consider appropriate.
 - i. Appoint such committees as the Board deems necessary including, but not limited to an Architectural Committee, Landscape Committee or Nominating Committee.

Article VIII Officers and Their Duties

8.1 Enumeration of Officers: The officers of the Association shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer and such other officers as the Board may from time to time appoint. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person.

- 8.2 *Election of Officers*: The election or appointment of officers shall take place at the first meeting of the Board of Directors following each annual meeting of the members.
- 8.3 *Term:* The officers shall be elected or appointed annually by the Board and each shall hold office for one year or until a successor has been designated.
- 8.4 Resignation and Removal: Any officer may resign at any time giving written notice to the Board, the President, or the Secretary. A resignation shall take effect on the date of receipt of the notice or at any later time specified in the notice of resignation. Acceptance of a resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective. An officer may be removed from office, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
- 8.5 *Vacancies:* A vacancy in any office may be filled by appointment by the Board. The individual appointed to a vacant office shall serve for the remainder of the term of the officer being replaced.
- 8.6 Duties: The duties of the officers are as follows:
 - a. The President shall, in the absence of the Chairman, preside at all meetings of the Board, shall see that orders and resolutions of the Board are carried out, shall review the Association bank statements monthly, shall sign all leases, mortgages, deeds, and other written instruments and shall co-sign all promissory notes. In the President's absence, another officer is authorized to co-sign notes.
 - b. The Vice President shall act in the absence, inability, or refusal of the President to act, and shall discharge such other duties as required by the Board or the President.
 - c. The Secretary shall be the official record keeper of the Association, shall keep the minutes of all meeting and proceeding of the Board and of the members, serve notice of meetings, keep appropriate and current records, and perform other duties as required by the Board or the President.
 - d. The Treasurer shall oversee receipt and deposit of all moneys of the Association, disbursement of such funds, sign all checks and promissory notes, assure that accurate and current financial books of account are kept, oversee preparation and publication of the

annual budget, statement of revenue and expense, and perform other duties as required by the Board or the President. In the Treasurer's absence, another officer is authorized to sign checks.

Article IX Books and Records

The books, records, and papers of the Association shall, by appointment upon three days prior request, during business hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, be available and open for inspection by any member. Copies of any records shall be made at the prevailing cost for copies at the time a request for copies is made.

Article X Assessments

Each Member is obligated to pay the Association regular, special and limited Assessments which are secured by a continuing lien upon the Property against which the Assessment is made. Any Assessments which are not paid when due shall be delinquent. If the Assessment is not paid within fifteen (30) days after the due date, the Assessment shall bear interest from the due date at the rate of one and three quarters percent (1.75%) per month (21% APR), and the Association may bring an action at law against the Owner personally obligated to pay the Assessment or foreclose the lien against the Property, and interest, costs and reasonable attorney's fees any of such action shall be added to the amount of the Assessment. No Owner may waive or otherwise escape liability for the Assessments provided for herein by nonuse of the common Area or abandonment of said owner's lot.

Article XI Amendments

Amendments to these By-Laws may be made at any time at a regular or special meeting of the board of directors by a vote of a majority of a quorum of members of the board of directors present in person or by proxy.

Article XII Miscellaneous

- 12.1 *Conflicts:* In the event of a conflict between the Declaration and these By-Laws, the Declaration shall in all cases control. In the event of a conflict between the Articles of Incorporation and these By-Laws, the Articles of Incorporation shall in all cases control.
- 12.2 Fiscal Year: The fiscal year for the Association shall begin on the first day of January and end on the 31st day of December of each year.
