## General

Q. What is the contact information for the property management company?

A. You can contact **Riverside Property Management** at 208-376-1616, email [riversideboise@aol.com](mailto:riversideboise@aol.com) (identify yourself as a HF resident), or access their website at <http://www.riversidemanagement.com/>

Q. Where can I find all pertinent information about Henry's Fork HOA?

A. The Henry's Fork CC&R's and By-laws are the two main sources of HOA information. This information can be found at Riverside's Associations link under Henry's Fork.

Q. What changes or improvements need to be approved by the ACC?

A. Any changes made to the exterior of your home and all additions or improvements to your landscape or property must be approved by the ACC BEFORE starting work. Forms and other information regarding the approval process can be accessed through Riverside's Associations link under Henry's Fork.

Q. How long does it usually take for an ACC request to be approved?

A. Once you submit the **all** of the required forms, drawings, and samples, the Committee may take up to 30 days to approve your request.

Q. Who do I contact about annual dues payment questions?

A. Contact Riverside Property Management. You can mail the assessment to the address provided on your invoice .

Q. When will the irrigation be turned on/shut off?

A. The irrigation is turned on after the Dry Creek Canal is full, usually the middle of April. It is shut off in October. Signs will be posted at the entrances.

Q. When is the annual meeting held?

A. The annual meeting is held in early February.

Q. Does Henry's Fork have a Facebook page?

A. Yes. Search for Henry's Fork Community Page and ask to join. This is closed group open to residents only.

Q. Do we hold a community yard sale?

A. Yes. We hold it annually on various dates.

## Pool

Q. When does the pool open/close for the season?

A. The pool opens Memorial Day weekend and closes the second or third weekend of September, weather dependent.

Q. What are the pool hours?

A. The pool hours are from 8 am to 10 pm.

Q. Can I reserve the pool for personal parties?

A. Henry's Fork Pool is for all residents to use at any time. If you plan to hold a party there, please notify the community through our Facebook page as a courtesy.

Q. Can I invite guests to use the pool?

A. Henry's Fork residents can take guests to the pool. You are responsible for any incidents relating to guests.

Q. Where can I get a new pool key?

A. Contact the Riverside Property Management to obtain a new or replacement key.

Q. Who do I contact when my pool key isn't working?

A. Contact Riverside Property Management.

Q. Why is the pool closed or locked?

A. Contact Riverside Property Management with your question.

## Common Areas

Q. Who do I contact when my irrigation is off or sprinklers are broken in the common areas?

A. Contact the property management company for irrigation questions. Send them an email describing the location and, if possible, a photo of the sprinklers in question.

Q. What are the rules on fireworks in common areas?

A. Henry's Fork follows the city/county/state ordinance addressing fireworks. All aerial fireworks are banned. For safety and liability purposes, no fireworks of any type are allowed in common areas.

Q. Can I let my dog off-leash in the common areas and park?

A. Dogs are to be on a leash at all times in Henry's Fork. This rule is to prevent injuries to other pets and people using the common areas.

## Garbage and Recycling

Q. Is there a location close by where I can take our glass to be recycled?

A. You can take it to the recycle bins located just inside the entrance to Eagle City Office downtown. They are located on the west side of the entrance.

Q. Can cardboard and other items be recycled at the Eagle City Office location?

A. Yes. They will take the same items as those you place in your recycle bin.

Q. What time is garbage pickup on Tuesdays, and when should I place my bins at the curb?

A. Place your cans out by 7:00 a.m. There is no set time as to when they come through the subdivision. Recycling is collected every other week.
